Violinist Julia Glenn's playing has been described as "gripping" (New York Times) and "fully focused and betraying not one whit of insecurity" (Boston Musical Intelligencer). A third-year doctoral candidate at The Juilliard School, she obtained her master's from New England Conservatory in 2013 and her bachelor's in linguistics magna cum laude from Harvard University in 2012.

A devoted solo and chamber musician, Julia has concertized widely and has recently appeared on stages including Alice Tully Hall, Carnegie Hall's Weill Hall, Sanders Theatre, Jordan Hall, the Beijing Recital Hall and Shanghai Concert Hall. Projects from fall 2015 included work on a solo album and chamber projects with Alan Gilbert and the Aeolus Quartet. This spring she will make concerto appearances with the North Bay Symphony and the New Juilliard Ensemble, the latter of which will mark the world premiere of Milton Babbitt's violin concerto.
