VICKY WANG, CELLO

Winner of the Young Artist International Competition, cellist Vicky Wang made her New York debut in Carnegie's Weill Recital Hall in 2001. As an avid chamber musician, Vicky was a member of the award-winning ensemble the Aristos String Quartet. The ensemble performed in the Hampden-Sydney Chamber Music Festival in Virginia and frequently collaborated with the Chamber Music Society of Lincoln Center in its lecture-concert series. Vicky's concert highlights also include collaborations with legendary performers Ray Charles at the Belleayer Music Festival and Liza Minelli at Avery Fisher Hall.

Prior to relocating to California, Vicky served on the faculty of Mannes College of Music and the Aaron Copland School of Music at Queens College. She currently maintains an active teaching studio in Palo Alto. Her students have been featured as concerto soloists with El Camino Youth Symphony, California Youth Symphony, and Palo Alto Chamber Orchestra. She is a founding member of C'est Bon Chamber Music Academy in Los Altos California and the San Francisco Cello Quartet. In 2017, Vicky will be returning as an Artist Teacher for The pianoSonoma Music Festival and will be joining the faculty of University of Pacific Conservatory of Music and serve as the cellist of its faculty ensemble - Trio 180
