## **DECEMBER 2015 HOLIDAY SEASON AT THE GREEN MUSIC CENTER**

(Sonoma County, CA) — Sonoma State University's Green Music Center presents performances featuring Pacifica Quartet with Orion Weiss, the Soweto Gospel Choir and Philharmonia Baroque Orchestra throughout the month of December in Weill Hall. These final Green Music Center performances of 2015 celebrate winter and the holiday season and highlight the world-class chamber, world and orchestral offerings featured throughout the 2015–16 Weill Hall season.

The MasterCard Performance Series continues with the Indiana-based string ensemble, **Pacifica Quartet** in a program including Beethoven's String Quartet in F major, Janácek's String Quartet No. 2 and Brahms' Piano Quintet in F minor featuring pianist **Orion Weiss** (Dec. 13). Please note that Orion Weiss replaces the previously announced Menahem Pressler in this program.

The sound and spirit of the holidays fill Weill Hall with two special seasonal performances: South Africa's Grammy Award-winning **Soweto Gospel Choir** mixes African gospel with traditional hymns, Jamaican reggae and American pop in a program of both holiday favorites and new traditions (Dec. 18). San Francisco's **Philharmonia Baroque Orchestra**, conducted by **Nicholas McGegan**, returns to Weill Hall with Handel's beloved Messiah, also featuring the **Philharmonia Chorale** (Bruce Lamott, director) and vocal soloists **Amanda Forsyth**, **Meg Bragle**, **Isaiah Bell** and **Philip Cutlip** (Dec. 20).
